Essential Suturing Skills in Acute Care

This 3-hour practical suturing workshop is designed for clinicians working in acute and emergency care who want to build confidence with wound assessment and basic suturing skills. The session is highly hands-on and suitable for beginners, with no prior suturing experience required.

Topics Covered:

- Overview of assessment and cleaning of acute wounds
- Practical techniques for ring removal
- Digital ring block and local anaesthetic infiltration
- Core suturing skills, including:
  - Single interrupted sutures
  - Hidden subcutaneous skin closure
  - Knot tying fundamentals, with demonstration and practice of:
    - Quad surgeon's knot
    - Aberdeen tie

Participants will be guided step by step through each technique, practising from first principles in a supportive learning environment.  
Each participant will receive a take-home suturing training kit.

This 3-hour practical workshop takes a multimodal approach to rhythm interpretation and telemetry monitoring in the acute setting. Ideal for those working in emergency care.

Participants will work through 16 different Lead II strips, with handouts provided.

This session will be led by Rob Timmings, Principal Nurse Educator for ECT4Health and Rural/Remote Nurse Educator for NW Health & Hospital in Queensland. Rob is an RN with 37 years of experience in critical care, hyperbaric medicine, and flight retrieval. He has a passion for assessment skills, physiology, and pharmacology and provides education and consultancy to hospitals, RFDS, and healthcare facilities to support ongoing staff development.
